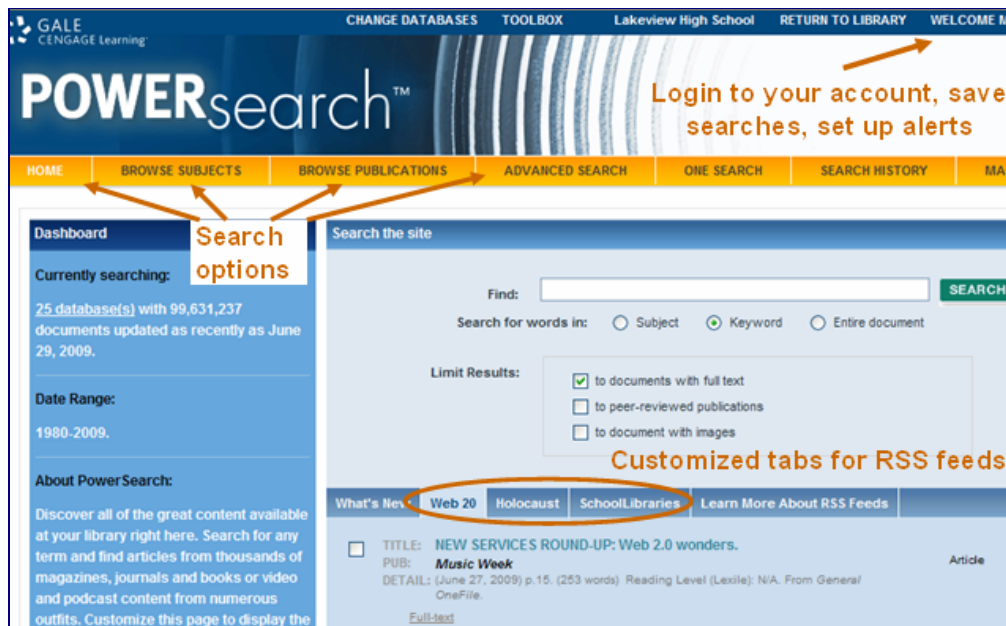


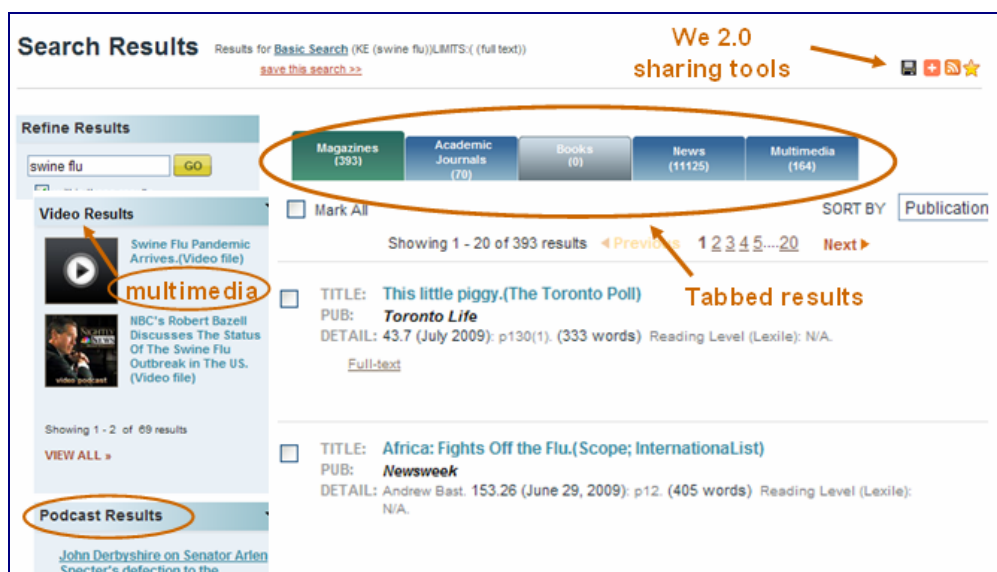
Michigan eLibrary (MeL) Update 2009

1. Gale Database Enhancements

- New PowerSearch homepage offers a web-like design, ability to do basic search, browse subjects, browse publications or perform an advanced search.
- A user may set up an individual account, save searches and set up alerts.
- Customized tabs for RSS feeds can also be set up on main PowerSearch page.
- Dashboard to the left of screen indicates which databases user is cross-searching, when the documents were last updated and the amount of records user is searching.



- Search results page gives quick access to multimedia items such as videos, images and podcasts. Results are also tabbed by material type.
- Web 2.0 sharing tools are readily available.



- Expanded search options include the ability to Browse Subjects or Browse Publications.

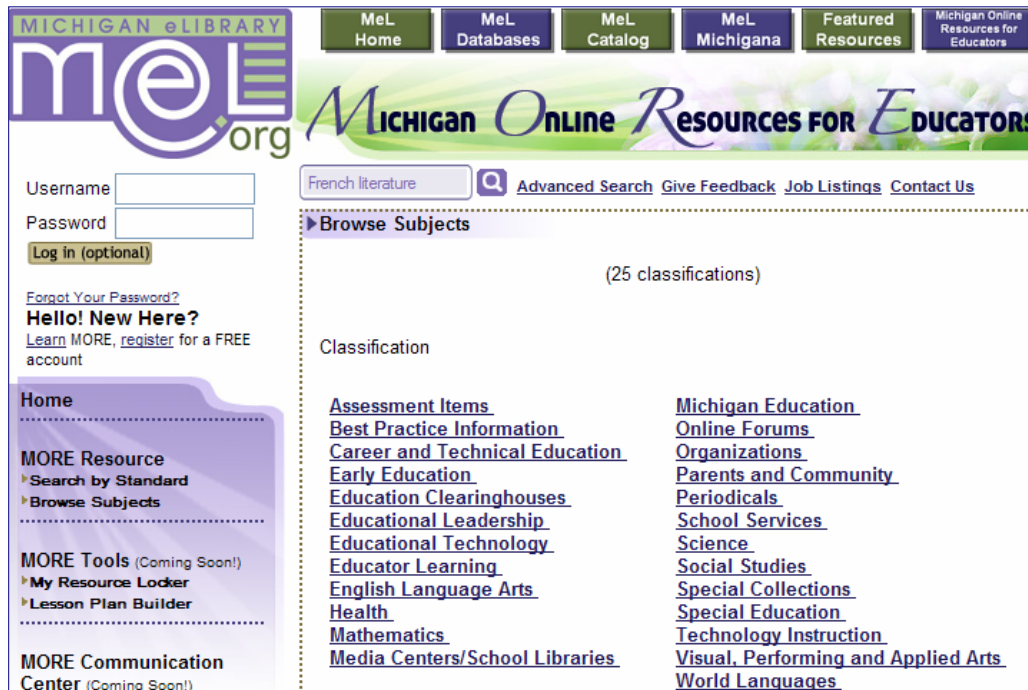

- Provides thousands of quality educational Websites tied to the state's curriculum and professional development needs.
- A project of the Library of Michigan, Michigan Department of Education and Wayne State University.
- Browse the subject tree or do a search on a specific term.



- An annotated list of results is returned. Link to a result or display the full record.
- Advanced Search lets user find materials by keyword, resource type and audience.
- Search by Standards locates materials by drilling down through Grade Level Content Expectations (GLCEs) and High School Content Expectations (HSCSs). Computer icon indicates that a MORE resource is associated with a particular standard.
